1	accident, actually	Words ending in -ally (suffix with double “l”)
2	address, appear, arrive	Double consonants at start / tricky vowel beginnings
3	answer, complete	Silent letters (w in “answer”), long vowel “ete”
4	believe, bicycle	ie/ei spelling pattern
5	breath, breathe	Adding silent e changes short vowel to long
6	build, busy, business	Unusual vowel sounds (“u” says /i/)
7	calendar, caught	Tricky vowel spellings (ar, au)
8	centre, century, certain	Words with cent (Latin root “hundred”)
9	circle, decide	Soft c before e/i/y
10	describe, different	Prefix de-, di-
11	difficult, disappear	Prefix dis- (opposite/negative)
12	early, earth	Words with ear making /ur/ sound
13	eight, eighth	Number words – irregular spelling
14	enough, exercise	“ough” making /uff/, ex- prefix
15	experience, experiment	Prefix ex- (out of/away from)
16	extreme, famous	Prefix ex- , suffix -ous
17	favourite, February	Tricky middle letters (silent r)
18	forward(s), fruit	Unusual vowel patterns (ui, ou)
19	grammar, group	Double consonants, “gr-” cluster
20	guard, guide	Silent “u” after g
21	appear / arrive revision	Review: vowel beginnings
22	difficult / different / disappear	Review: dis- / di- prefix
23	favourite / February / forward(s)	Review: unusual vowels & silent letters
24	caught / centre / century	Review: au and cent root
25	breathe / breath / believe	Review: vowel changes & ie
26	exercise / experience / experiment	Review: ex- prefix
27	business / eighth / potatoes prep	Review: plurals & irregular spellings
28	earth / early / heart prep	Review: ear words
